If he is a man who is needed to help the Muslims, he should not observe i'tikaaf, because helping the Muslims is more important than i'tikaaf, because helping others is benefiting both parties and good actions from which others also benefit are better than actions from which only the doer benefits, except in the case of actions that are regarded as requirements and obligations of Islam.
